

Hebrew Free Loan Society (HFLS) Income Limits - 2017

HFLS makes interest-free loans to low- and moderate-income residents of NYC's five boroughs, Westchester, and Long Island. Our income limits are based on the median family income for the NYC area adjusted for different household sizes, following guidelines determined by the Department of Housing and Urban Development.

To determine whether you qualify for an HFLS loan:

Locate your household size in the chart below. If your pre-tax annual household income is at or below the amount listed for your household size, you are eligible to apply for an HFLS loan. If your annual household income exceeds this amount, please contact HFLS at (212) 687-0188 or info@hfls.org to discuss whether you qualify for a loan based on your specific situation.
