## SELIM AND RACHEL BENIN SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM GUIDELINES

- 1. Mr. Albert Benin has established a fund at the United Jewish Appeal-Federation of New York that provides scholarships to exceptional Jewish graduate students with substantial economic need in the physical sciences, engineering, computer science, mathematics, biological sciences or medical fields.
- 2. Applicants must be Jewish residents of the geographical area now under the jurisdiction of the State of Israel, or Israeli Jewish students temporarily residing within the United States.
- 3. Applicants must be students at graduate or professional schools located in the United States. Students attending the Sackler School of Medicine are no longer eligible for this scholarship.
- 4. The scholarships are intended to represent meaningful amounts. A commitment to each student will be limited to one year at a time. Scholarships may be renewed for another year, but students must reapply each year.
- 5. All scholarship decisions are final.
